

Scholarships for the 2023-24 School Year New Students Entering Grades K-12 Apply Now!



There are two ways to apply for financial assistance for your child's educational needs:

• Education Freedom Accounts (EFA)



• Education Tax Credit (ETC) scholarships

Please note, if you are eligible it is possible to apply for and receive assistance through *both* programs.



Am I eligible?

To be eligible:

- 1 You must be a New Hampshire resident. (EFA and ETC)
- Your child must be at least 5 years old and no older than 20 years old and entering K–12th grade. (EFA and ETC)
- Sour family's income must be at or below 300% of the federal poverty level guidelines shown in the chart below. (EFA and ETC)

You must complete the application process and sign the EFA agreement, which includes agreeing to share academic accountability documents. (EFA only)

DEADLINES: <u>The deadline to apply for a full EFA is **Monday**, **July 17th**, **2023**</u>. There is no deadline for new applications for ETC scholarships, but you are encouraged to apply as soon as possible because the scholarships are first come, first served.
